

Calculating Discounts and Taxes

Discounts are calculated on the original price and then taken off.

For example: A \$30.00 sweater is on sale, 20% off.

1. Calculate the amount of the discount. 20% of \$30.00
= 0.20×30.00
= 6.00

New price is $\$30.00 - \$6.00 = \$24.00$

Taxes are calculated on the original price and then added.

2. Calculate the amount of the taxes. See ccc - GST and PST

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
